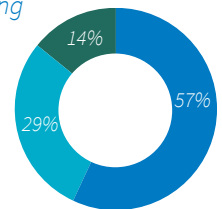


JOB OPPORTUNITIES

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students who have completed their previous education in English are exempted from this requirement. All other students need to provide proof that they are proficient in the English language. HAS advises the IELTS language test (www.ielts.org). Overall band score (academic programma) has to be at least 6.0.
